### Giving Back Scholarship

The Bayfield Education Foundation is happy match the donations made each year by the graduating class in order to provide scholarships to deserving Bayfield graduates who have participated in a community service project. Please read our guidelines, supply the required information, and complete the essay questions. The completed essays and personal information should be submitted to your counselor no later than May 1, 2018.

#### Scholarship Guidelines

- The Giving Back Scholarship will be awarded each year to a BHS senior who will seek postgraduate education. Students who will attend a trade schools, community colleges or four-year institutions may apply for these funds.
- Priority will be placed upon those applicants who have participated in a community service project in our area.
- The scholarship will be awarded at the BHS Academic Awards Ceremony in May.
- If you are selected you have the option of having the entire amount applied to your first semester's tuition, or to have it divided equally for the first two semesters. You should indicate in writing which option you choose, prior to the start of your first semester. You may request to have it divided equally for the first two semesters but you must do so in writing prior to the start of fall classes. Should you not enroll for the fall semester, your scholarship will be put in escrow for your use in the spring semester if you enroll then. You must notify us in writing of your registration for the spring semester prior to the start of second semester classes.
- You must notify the Foundation if you plan on taking a “gap” year. The money will be held in the escrow account and will be available in the fall following your gap year. Again, you must notify the Foundation of your registration for the fall following your “gap” year in order to receive your scholarship.
